On the occasion of the celebration of Founder's Day, we want to invite all the adults of the National Scout Organizations of the Interamerica Region that have completed their basic training process (Wood Badge) to the Gilwell Interamerican 2023 Meeting.

Objective

Generate a space for meeting, celebration, and reflection for adults from the Interamerican Region who have completed their basic training and are part of the Gilwell 1 Group.

Date and modality

The meeting will take place on Saturday, February 25 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Panama UTC-5 in virtual mode through the Zoom platform, once the registration is made in this [link](#), the instructions for entering the call will be sent to the participants **two days before the event.**

Cost and registration process

The registration form will **only be open until February 22 at 8:00 p.m. Panama UTC-5** or until the maximum capacity of the event is completed.

As it is an open event and part of the Founder's Day celebration, it will be free of charge, validation by the NSOs of the participants will not be required and it will be promoted by the official social networks of the World Scout Bureau - Interamerica Support Center.

As registration requirements, participants must attach the following **two** documents when completing the form:

1. Safe from Harm on-line course certification. As usual, participants are required to present the Safe from Harm course certificate. During this year 2023, while the transition is taking place, we will continue to receive the certificate of the previous course if it has completed on a date after January 2020.

2. Wood Badge Certificate. Certificate or letter that your NSO has given you at the end of your basic training process (Wood Badge)


Once compliance with **the two** requirements has been verified, the link and instructions for the call via zoom will be sent to the email registered by each participant.
