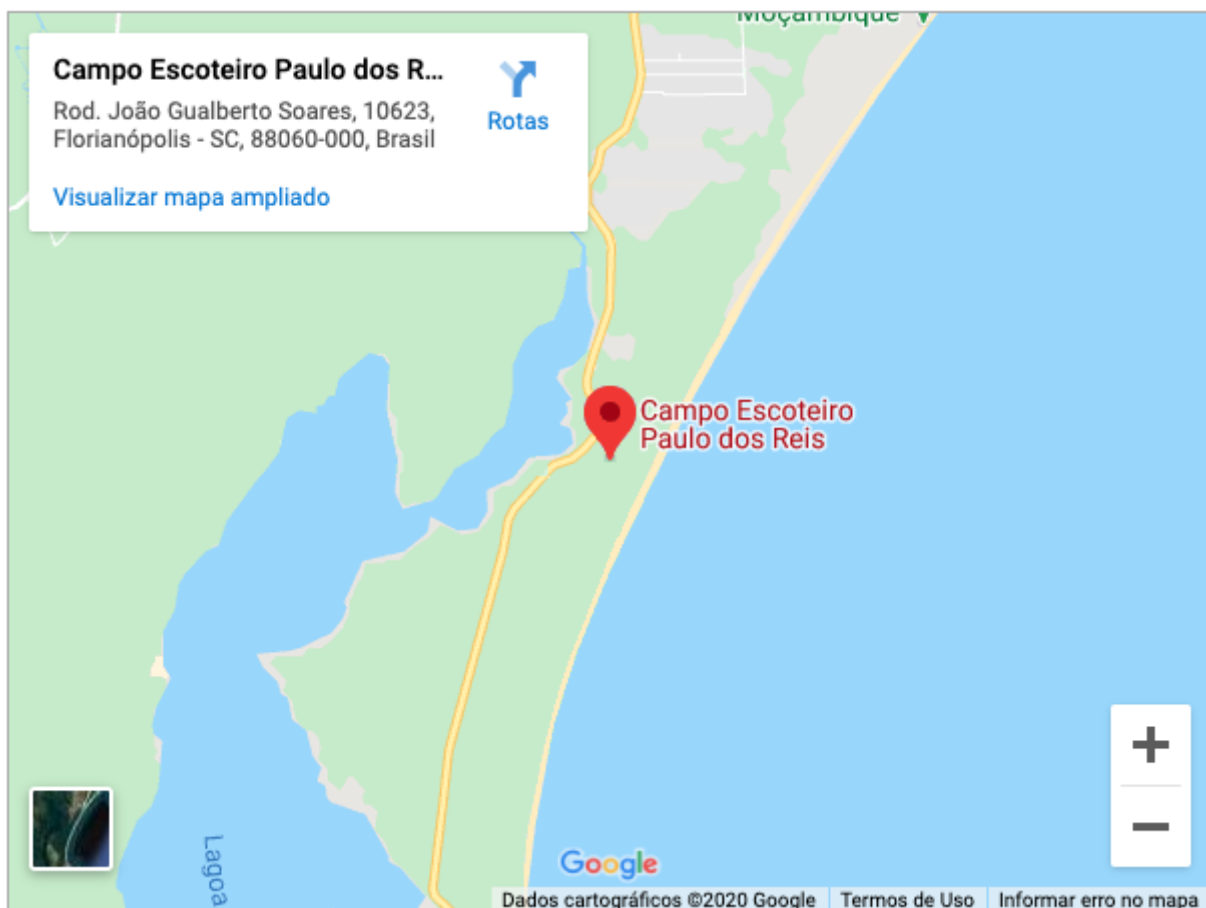

Environmental features of the Centre:

Access to surrounding environmental places of interest:



This Scout Centre has a trail that allows visitors to walk from the camping area to the beach of Mozambique. Another five beaches are less than 10km away. In addition, visitors can take a boat trip to Lagoa da Conceição to get to know the Trail and Cachoeria of the Lagoa Coast and enjoy the typical food of the region in the fishing village.

Environmental Education Programmes Available:



Regarding the Scout Centre Environmental Education Program, we can highlight the opportunity for participants to learn about the actions of sea turtle conservation by TAMAR Project, to know the actions developed to rescue and treat wild animals of the Park at vulnerability and risk, and work in a community vegetable garden.

Among the many actions included in the policy and practices of this Scout Centre is the reuse of rainwater, waste management, future deployment of solar panels for power generation and the non-use of disposable but reusable materials.
