Access to surrounding environmental places of interest: Out of the 16 different sorts of amphibians living in the fens, 11 can be found in the area around St Walrick, including the common spadefoot toad. Badgers and bats also inhabit the area. Although the badger was near to extinction not so long ago, it has made a revival and the numbers are on the increase. Our terrain is home to a group badgers. The areas where the badgers make their dens are closed to our guests, so not to disturb their habitat.

The children discover aquatic life, not only in the fen on our site but also in the surrounding fens, and a nature hike through the surrounding terrain. There is also The St George hike, which dates back to the 50's, has been successfully completed by almost 2000 scouts. The hike begins in Nijmegen and finishes on our own terrain. This hike has made a restart in 2015. We also have a diversity of hikes and games with the nature as theme. You can use our solar oven (since 2019). Groups prepare food using the power of the sun. Off course the staff at St Walrick are happy to inform you about the surrounding nature and the sustainable management of St Walrick terrain.



Environmental Management of the Centre : Everything we do is based on the three P's people, planet and profit. Our main building is completely CO2 neutral. We make our hot water, for showers and heating by solar energy, we make our electricity by solar energy. All lightning is LED, Refuse is being recycled.
