Environmental features of the Centre:

Around Stubbergaard Lake (all considered protected nature) a approximately 14 km marked route exists. Here a range of nature experiences awaits eg. Dense forrest, wild boar reserve and open moor. At the tip of the lake 2 small moor houses called "Hedehusene" is placed. By one of the houses a plate with information about the nature reserve along with historical information is placed

Environmental Education Programmes Available:

At Trevaeld we have a wide catalogue of activities and the following is some examples: Activities on the lake eg. Canoeing, kayak polo, raft building and reed boats (as part of nature care and regulation program), Spoon and mug fabrication from nature resources, Leather animals – made from discarded leather remains - etc.



Environmental Management of the Centre:

"We possess the second largest solar cell panel of Holstebro Municipality generating 48 kW which provides so much power during a year that we are self-sufficient. Besides that, the centre has a ground-source heat-pump system driven by the power from the solar cells which makes us completely independent of fossil fuels. In the new lavatory building from 2014 a reversible cycle air conditioner is installed which heats up the building as well as the water."
