**Call for nominations to the Young Adult Members Group for 2012~2015**

Dear Colleagues,

Warm greetings from Manila!

Following the concept of the Young Adult Members Group currently in practice in the Asia-Pacific Region, the 7th APR Scout Youth Forum, which will be held in Dhaka, Bangladesh will elect the fourth batch of the Young Adult Members Group for a period of three years (2012-2015).

The following Young Adult Members who were elected during the 6th APR Scout Youth Forum (2009, Malaysia) will retire at the 7th APR Scout Youth Forum:

- Dicky Lam Kwok Hei (Hong Kong)
- Ari Wijanarko Adipratomo (Indonesia)
- Seo Ji Eun (Republic of Korea)

The number of young people to be elected will be determined by the number of Priority Areas for the triennium, which should be equal to the number of Sub-Committee created by the APR Scout Committee. For the next triennium, the APR Scout Committee created five sub-committees and therefore, the 7th APR Scout Youth Forum will be electing six [6] young people to the Adult Members Group. One of the elected young adult members, who will become the chairman of the group, will be an ex-officio member of the Regional Scout Committee.

We would like to call for nominations for Young Adult Members Group. If your NSO wishes to make a nomination, the enclosed nomination form, duly filled and endorsed, must reach the World Scout Bureau by **15 August 2012**. It is very important to note that putting a candidate forward means that you are aware of the role and responsibility of the NSO and that the NSO agrees to support their candidate if elected.

As there should only be one candidate per NSO, we would like you to endorse one candidate from among your participants to the 7th APR Scout Youth Forum. The consent of the nominee must also be obtained before his/her name is submitted. Names of the candidates nominated to the Young Adult Members Group will be announced by 30 August 2012.
