The objective of the break-out groups is to gather participants in groups so that they will be able to discuss extensively any one of the five pre-selected topics which are considered focal issues in the Asia-Pacific Region. The topics are:

1. Asia-Pacific Regional Plan 2012~2015
2. Human Rights
3. Innovative Leadership
4. Media Relations
5. Global Support System and Messenger of Peace (MoP)

All your delegates and observers are welcome to participate in any one of the above sessions. Please divide your delegates and observers into the above five pre-selected topics based on their interest and/or the position they hold in your NSO to prepare for the topic of their choice.

### **Suggested Strategy**

A tentative list is to be prepared by APR Office in advance, which will be posted at a conspicuous area at the conference. Announcement will be made at the preliminary session.

The break-out group session will have three parts – [1] input [2] group discussion and summary at Break Out Group level; and finally [3] reports by topics, which shall include a discussion at the plenary.
