**30<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree - 2013**

Dear Colleagues,

Greetings from Manila!



We are pleased to inform you that Scout Association of Japan will host the 30<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree in conjunction with their 16<sup>th</sup> National Jamboree.

The Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree is being organized as a major Scouting event of the region. This is aimed at giving additional opportunity to young people between the ages 12 - 17 years old, to take part in such event at least once in his/her lifetime as a Scout.

This Jamboree will also serve as the dry run of the forthcoming 23rd World Scout Jamboree in 2015.

Below are the basic information of the Jamboree:

**Date:** 1 – 7 August 2013. Participants are requested to arrive 31 July 2013 and may leave 8 August 2013.

**Venue :** Kirara-hama, Yamaguchi City, Yamaguchi Prefecture

**Theme:** “Wa – a Spirit of Unity”

**Fee:** Overseas APR NSOs:

Participants & ISTs on Category A & B: JPY 25,000.00 [approx. USD325.00]

Participants & ISTs: Category C & D JPY 45,000.00 [approx. USD585.00]

Other NSOs: JPY 50,000.00 [approx. USD650.00]

Please note that the Jamboree fee should be paid in Japanese Yen. Any difference on the amount paid against the registration fee will be settled upon the arrival of the contingent at the Jamboree site.

Jamboree fee includes inland transportation, meals (from dinner of 31 July to breakfast of 8 July), participants kit, and Jamboree Programme.

- Programme: Global Development Village, Crossroads of Culture, City of Science, Sub-Camp Life and others. Off-site activities will include a visit to the historical Hiroshima Site.
- Eligibility: The Jamboree is organized for young people both male and female aged 12 to 17 years old. International Service Team (IST) should be above 18 years old and ideally not above 45 years old.
- Expected Participants: 14,000 participants from Japan and about 2,000 from overseas.
- Weather: Minimum average temperature in August is around 24.3 degrees Celsius and maximum average temperature of 32.9 degrees Celsius.


