10th National Rover Moot and 5th National COMDECA - Bangladesh

Greetings from Manila!

We are pleased to inform you that Bangladesh Scouts is organizing the 10th Rover Moot & 5th National COMDECA from 25-31 January, 2013 at the "Moynamotir Char", Debiganj Upazilla, Panchagar in Bangladesh.

The Moot & Community Development Camp (COMDECA) is organized to promote and strengthen peace, solidarity and cooperation among young people by providing them opportunities to be together and engage in various activities.

On behalf of Bangladesh Scouts, we are pleased to invite Scouts and Rovers to this event.

Basic Information about the event:

Date: 25-31 January, 2013
Participants are requested to arrive at the camp on 24 January 2013 and depart on 1 February 2013

Venue: "Moynamotir Char", Debiganj Upazilla, Panchagar, Bangladesh

Debiganj is in the Panchagar district which is in the North Western part of Bangladesh near the border of India. It is around 300 km away from Dhaka and takes seven hours by bus to reach there. By train it takes eight hours to reach Saidpur, and one hour more by bus from Saidpur to Debiganj. There are domestic flights from Dhaka-Saidpur-Dhaka

Theme: "Scouting for Development and Peace"

Fee: Registration fee is USD100.00. The fee includes inland transportation, food from dinner of 24 January to breakfast of 1 February and Moot & COMDECA kit.

- Eligibility: Scouts aged between 14-16 years and Rover Scouts aged between 17-25 years may attend this event.
- Weather: Weather in Panchagar will be cold. Temperature will be around 10 degrees Celsius at night and around 15-20 degrees Celsius at daytime. Warm clothes and blankets/sleeping bags will be required at night.
- Equipment: Participants are requested to bring Scout Uniform, NSO Flag, National Flag, a CD of National Anthem, Compass, Sleeping bag, Blanket, toiletries, pair of shorts, personal medicine, torch or flashlight, warm clothes and other necessary personal belongings.
- One tent will be provided for each patrol of 8 Scouts/ Rover Scouts. Participants are requested to bring sleeping bags.
